Talcott Free Library Board of Trustees Positions up for Election Spring 2017

Are you interested in finding a way to serve your community? Do you understand the importance of the mission of public libraries? Then the Talcott Free Library Board of Trustees wants you!

The Library Board is seeking civic-minded individuals with an interest in library services in their community to fill several openings on the board next spring. To qualify to serve, an applicant must reside within the Talcott Free Library District and be 18 years of age or older. The Talcott Free Library Board is composed of seven members; on average, the trustee position takes a commitment of up to 2-4 hours per month, which includes monthly Board meetings and preparation. The Board of Trustees regularly meets on the first Monday of each month at 7p.m. These available positions will begin in May 2017, with petitions for election due to the county by early December this year.

This volunteer position involves a willingness to represent the public interest in libraries and assist with policy development, financial management, local partnerships and advocacy efforts.
